Fare: With sponsor from the Education Bureau, the total tour fee per person is HK\$859.5 (original fare HK\$2,865)

The Board of Directors of the Pok Oi Hospital sponsors HK\$109.5 per student.

Fare per student is HK\$750 (including transportation fee, meals, accommodation and insurance).

Should more than 80 students apply for the study tour; the school will use a lucky draw system on the 7th January 2020 to choose which students will participate in the tour. For the students staying behind, the school will arrange for them to participate in the Life-Wide-Learning Day, and local activities.
